the County of Henry Provisionally now DeKalb City
containing one Acre and one & quarter acres more
or less known & distinguished by lot no two hundred
& thirty one in the Eighteenth District of said County
being the East half of said Lot To have & to hold

Henderson his heirs & assigns together with all & singular
the rights members & appurtenances thereof to the same
