Georgia This Indenture made the twenty first day of DeKalb County, February A.D. one thousand eight hundred and forty two between John Gillum Sen. on the one part and John Gillum Jun. of the other part both of the County aforesaid witnesseth that the said John Gillum Sen. for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said John Gillum Jun. at and before the signing sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant sell and convey unto the said John Gillum Jun. his heirs and assigns fifty acres of land lying and being in the seventeenth district of originally Henry but now DeKalb known and distinguished in the plan of Survey by No 261 the said fifty acres of Land lying in the NW corner of said lot of Land to have and to hold said fifty acres or parcel of Land unto him the said John Gillum Jun. his heirs and assigns together with all and singular the rights members appertaining thereto to the same or in any manner belonging to his and their own proper use benefit and behoof forever and fee simple and the said John Gillum Sen. for himself his heirs executors and administrators to the said bargained land unto the said John Gillum Jun. his heirs and assigns will warrant and forever defend the right and title thereof against himself and against the claims of all the persons whatsoever claiming the same So witnesseth whereof the said John Gillum Sen. hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year above written signed sealed and delivered in the presence of
