Barren County of the County of Jasper & State of Georgia have this
day lawfully ordained and appointed J. W. Wentworth of the
County of Barren (damestably my true & lawful attorney in fact
for me & in my name to sell out or lease fractions of one hun-
dred and sixty nine and one hundred & seventy lying & being
in the third district of Barren County also to take the entire
management of summary executions which I hold against
Barren County Knight of Barren County and pursue any course
the said Attorney may think proper relative to the manage-
ment of the same so as to sell all and every species of property
belonging to the aforesaid Barren County Knight and execute
titles for me & in my name as attorney aforesaid to any person
or persons that he may sell the property so purchased to for the
particular benefit of the creditors of the aforesaid Barren County
Knight whose acts and deeds as above described shall be
fully & effectually ratified by me as the donee in and by my
own proper person in testimony whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and seal this 21st day of August 1833

Georgia Know all men by these presents that I J. W. Wentworth
Barren County of the County of Jasper & State of Georgia have this day bound an attorney
aforesaid the aforesaid John Knight in the penal sum of Three
hundred dollars for the true payment of which I bind the
aforesaid John Knight his heirs &c. to Elijah Bird of DeKalb
County his heirs &c. jointly & firmly by these presents sealed
with my seal & dated this 7th day of August 1834

The conditions of the above obligations are such that should the
aforesaid Elijah Bird who I have this day sold lot No. 130
one hundred & thirty in the fifteenth dist. formerly Henry
now DeKalb to as the attorney in fact and in such sale agreed
to guard the aforesaid Elijah Bird against any suit should
a suit at law be commenced against the aforesaid Elijah Bird
for the premises thus sold and on such suit being adjusted so that
the aforesaid Elijah shall sustain no damage whatever this
instrument to be null & void otherwise remains in full force &
virtue against the aforesaid John Knight his heirs &c. In
