provided nevertheless that if the said Robert his heirs
Executors and administrators shall and do or so
truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Margant
his heirs & assigns the former mentioned sum of two
hundred & forty dollars on the day and time mentioned
and appointed for the payment thereof in the said
promissory note according to the term of said note
then and from thenceforth as well as this present in
term and the right to the land thereby conveyed
as the said promissory note shall require
