

Georgia This Indenture made this the twenty
of March County day of February in the year of our Lord
February 6th 1840 One thousand eight hundred & forty two
John W Ferry of the State and County aforesaid of the one
part and James Gandy of the same place of the other part
Witnesseth that the said John W Ferry for and in Consideration
of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars to him in
hand paid at and before the sealing and delivering of these
presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged hath
granted bargained sold and conveyed and do by these presents
grant bargain sell and convey unto the said James Gandy
his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land
situate lying and being in said County on the waters of
the Little Creek composing all the one fourth part
of lot No 55 in the Four Hundred district of Oconee
County but now DeKalb County a square taken off the
said lot last corner of said lot which which was granted
to joining Lavina Shumard on the north and L Hammens
on the south & have and to hold the said one fourth
on the south east corner unto him the said James Gandy
his heirs and assigns together with all and singular the
rights, members and appurtenances therof to the same in
any manner belonging to his and their own proper use
benefit and behoof for ever in particular and the said
John W Ferry for his heirs executors and administrators
the said bargained premises unto the said James Gandy
his heirs and assigns warrant and defend the rights
and titles against themselves and all other claimants
whatever in testimony whereof the said John W Ferry hath
hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year first
above written signed sealed and delivered in presence of
