of land situate lying and being in the sixteenth (16) district of originally
Henry now DeKalb county and known and distinguished in the plan of
said district by the number one hundred and thirty six (136) containing
fifty acres more or less, it being one fourth part of said lot in the

To have and to hold the said bargained property to him the said Thomas his heirs and assigns to their only benefit & behoof forever and I the said Stephen P. my heirs & assigns the said the said bargained property unto the said Thomas his heirs and assigns all by these presents forever warrant & defend against claims of all other persons or persons whatsoever Provided notwithstanding if the said Stephen his heirs and assigns shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Thomas the above mentioned sum of three hundred & seven dollars & forty cents on the day and time mentioned for the payment of said note the 31st Dec^r next then and thenceforth as well these presents Indenture as the right thereto claimed & conveyed as the said promissory note shall cease & be void to all intents & purposes In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the day and date above written
