both parties bargained sold and conveyed unto
grant bargained sell and convey unto the said Abington
Bunt and Delona Bunt all that tract and parcel
of land lying being & situate known & distinguished
by lot No fifty four in the sixteenth District especially
laid out in D. Hall County containing two hundred two and a
half acres more or less To have and to hold said tract or
parcel of land unto them the said Abington Bunt and
Delona Bunt their heirs and assigns together with all and
singular the rights Members and appurtenances thereof in
any manner belonging to their own proper benefit and behoof
Forever in fee simple and the said Joseph Morton for
himself his heirs Executors and administrators the said
bargained promise unto the said Abington Bunt & Delona
Bunt their heirs and assigns will warrant & defend
the right and title thereof against themselves and
against the claims of all other persons who demand
in Witness whereof the said Joseph Morton hath
hereunto set his hand and seal the day and date
above written signed sealed and delivered in presence

consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty
dollars to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and
delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged both parties bargained sold and conveyed and
with by these presents grant bargained sell and convey unto
the said Amos Vincent his heirs and assigns all that
tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in form
and being more especially known by lot No one
hundred and eighty three (183) to have and to hold
