whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Joseph Wooton has this day
granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and convey unto the said Joshua Marbut all that tract or parcel
of land situate lying and being in the sixteenth (16) district of originally
Henry now DeKalb county and known and distinguished in the plan of
said district by the number one hundred and thirty six (136) containing
fifty acres more or less, it being one fourth part of said lot in the
north east corner of the same, To have and to hold the said tract or parcel
of land unto him the said Joshua Marbut his heirs and assigns,
together with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances
thereof to the same in any manner being and belonging to him and
his own proper use benefit and behoof forever in fee simple.
