Georgia This Indenture made and entered into by and between DeKalb County Georgia Wentworth of the one part attorney in fact for John Knight of Jasper County of the county aforesaid and Elizah Bird of the county of DeKalb same State Metropolitan that the aforesaid Wentworth attorney aforesaid for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars prompt payment and the further sum of fifty dollars embraced in a note & bearing date with this instrument due the twenty fifth day of December next signed by the aforesaid Elizah Bird have this day being the seventh day of August in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred & thirty four bargained sold and conveyed to the aforesaid Elizah Bird his heirs & assigns and by these presents do bargain sell and confirm all that tract or parcel of Land situate lying & being in the county of Henry formerly now De Kalb and in the plan of said county located in the fifteenth District fully & fairly known by lot (No 130) one hundred and thirty &c have and to hold the aforesaid lot of land with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances and the aforesaid Wentworth attorney aforesaid do hereby warrant & forever defend the above described premises from the claim or claims of the aforesaid John Knight his heirs & assigns to the aforesaid Elizah Bird his heirs executors & administrators and every other person in fee simple In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal on the day & year above written Wentworth

Georgia This Indenture made this the first day DeKalb County of January (1843) eighteen hundred and forty three between Calen Johnson of the one part and Elizah Bird of the other part both of the county and State aforesaid Metropolitan that the said Calen Johnson for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to me in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath this day bargained and sold unto the said Elizah Bird and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Elizah Bird his heirs and assigns a certain lot or parcel of Land lying and being in the fifteenth District of originally Henry now DeKalb County except that part of the lot or parcel lying on the South east corner South East of the branch the branch being this line (supposed forty acres) and known in the plan of said district by number one hundred and twenty seven 127 lying near the waters of Swamp fingered to have and to hold the above described lot of land together with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances thereto
