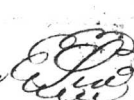

 adjacent to Edge Esq. it being originally Henry now F. Hall County  
 and the south half of said lot also one step girl named  
 Sarah about two years old also a small man bridle also a  
 road wagon painted blue also one bridle & harness  
 and I want it to turn out in the dispensation of Providence  
 that I should be called off without making a will &  
 give to my three named children all the remainder of  
 my property to them & them a little between them & their  
 heirs or instrument not to be lost for the want of form  
 or any thing technical therein contained to be taken by the  
 true intent & meaning as written my hand and seal this

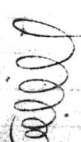
