ing one hundred and one fourth acres more or
less together with all and singular the rights, liberties &
appurtenances unto the said half lot of land being belong-
ing or in any wise appertaining and also all the estate right
title interest property claim and demand of the said
William Wood in law Equity or otherwise whatever of in
or to the same To have and to hold the said half lot
of land and premises and every part thereof unto the said
