 Witnesseth that the said Lewis Brock Thomas Brock & Shipton
 Sims for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred
 dollars to them in hand paid at the time of the making & delivery
 of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have granted bargained and sold and do by these presents grant
 bargain and sell to the aforesaid John R. C. Waller his heirs and
 assigns forever all that tract or lot of land situated lying and
 being in the fourthteenth district of Congressally Territory but now
 in the County of DeKalb which said lot is known and distin-
 guished in the plan of said district by the N. 44th Forty two having
 such shapes forms and marks and quantity as will manifestly
 appear by the original plat and grant issued from the
 Department of the State of Georgia the said lot of land was
 owned by Sabitha Workman of the State of Georgia and
 Georgia and sold to our Father by marriage and to us by the
 death of her and to her all and singular the rights
 members and appurtenances whatever or thence to belong
 for ever in full Shipton Sims and in the said Lewis Brock Thomas
 Brock and Shipton Sims do warrant and firm defend
 the premises aforesaid from ourselves our heirs Executors ad-
 ministrators and all and any other person or persons whatever unto
 the aforesaid John R. C. Waller his heirs and assigns for ever to
 his and their own proper use benefit and behoof in Witness
