This Indenture made this the twenty first day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four between Lucius L Wittich for his Attorney in fact Lucius L Wittich of the County of Morgan and State aforesaid of the one part and William Kerbit of the State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Lucius L Wittich for his Attorney in and for consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto the said William Kerbit his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of ground lying and being in the State aforesaid and County of DeKalb (formerly Henry) in the eighteenth district of (said Henry formerly) containing Two hundred two & a half acres more or less and known as Number Two hundred and fifty five (255) in said district To have and to hold said bargained land together with all and singular the rights and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said William Kerbit his heirs and assigns forever in fee simple and the said Lucius L Wittich for his Attorney for himself his heirs executors and administrators and assigns the said bargained lot of land unto the said William Kerbit his heirs and assigns executors and administrators will warrant and forever defend against the claim of the said Lucius L Wittich his heirs and assigns and of other persons whatsoever

Stephen P. Cash hath this day made and delivered to the said
William Nesbit his heirs and assigns a certain instrument in
writing commonly called a promissory note subscribed with
his own hand and name and the name of John Dalbs his
Security bearing date with these presents whereby the said
Stephen P. Cash & John Dalbs Security hath promised on or
before the first day of January next to pay the said William
Nesbit or bearer Three hundred and eighty five dollars
for value received of him Now for and in consideration
of the sum of five dollars to him in hand paid at and before
the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said William
Nesbit the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged as well for
securing the payment of the above mentioned promissory note

A man twenty eight years old Martha a girl fifteen years
old To have and to hold the said bargained property to the said
William Nesbit his heirs & assigns to his and their own proper
use benefit and behoof forever and the said Stephen P. Cash
for himself his heirs executors and administrators the said
bargained property unto the said William Nesbit his heirs
and assigns well warrant and defend against the claim
of himself and against the claim of all others whatever provided
nevertheless that if the said Stephen P. Cash his heirs
executors and administrators shall and well and truly
pay or cause to be paid unto the said William Nesbit his
heirs or assigns the aforesaid sum of Three hundred
and eighty five dollars on the day and time appointed
