consideration of three hundred Dollars to him in hand
paid by William M. McKee before the signing sealing and
delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged hath this day bargained sold aliened &
conveyed and do by these presents bargain sell alien and
convey unto the said William M. McKee all that parcel
or tract of land lying and being in the Eighteenth Dist
of originally being now D. Holt County known and
distinguished in the plan of said Dist by the No 79
shanty men To have and to hold the said bargained
premises unto him the said William M. McKee his heirs
& assigns forever in fee simple and I the said James
P. Barnes for myself my heirs and assigns unto the
said William M. McKee his heirs and assigns with warrant
and force against the lawful claim or claims of
all persons or persons whatever in Witness whereof the
said James P. Barnes hath this day set his hand and
affixed his seal the day and date above written

Georgia This Indenture made this 1st day
of March in the year of our Lord
eight hundred and forty three between Mary Campbell
of the County and State of Georgia of the one part and
William Ferguson of the same place of the other parts
Witnesseth that the said Mary Campbell hath this
day made and delivered to the said William Ferguson
the following note subscribed with her hand and bearing
own date in the three presents whereby the said Mary Campbell
hath promised to pay the said William Ferguson or bearer
hereof one dollar and 80 cents one day after date
for value Received Now for and in consideration of
the sum of five dollars by the said William Ferguson
to the said Mary Campbell in hand paid the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged as well as for the better
securing the payment of the aforesaid promissory note the
said Mary Campbell hath bargained sold aliened &
conveyed and do by these presents bargain sell alien and
convey unto the said William Ferguson his heirs and assigns a certain
large tract by the name of 'Wagon' about twenty five
acres or thereabouts To have and to hold the said bargained

negotiate unto the said William Ferguson his heirs and assigns to him and there own proper use benefit and behoof forever and the May Campbell for herself her heirs executors and administrators the said bargain and sale unto the said William Ferguson with warrant and force of law against the claim of herself and against her heirs and against the claim of all other persons whatsoever.

Provided Furthermore that if the said May Campbell her heirs executors and administrators shall need and and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said William Ferguson his heirs and assigns the aforesaid sum of twenty dollars and 83 cents by the twenty fifth day of December next the day appointed for the payment thereof with the lawful interest for the same according to the tenor of said note and contract then and from thenceforth as well the bill of sale and the right to the property thereby conveyed as the said promissory note shall cease determine and be void to all intents and purposes.

Witnesseth that the said Berry Ragdale hath this day for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred and sixteen Dollars to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and confirmed and by these presents hath granted bargained and confirmed unto the said Isaac Sooty his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the fifteenth District formerly known as the said and known in the plan of said District by containing four (94) containing two hundred two and a half acres more or less to him the said Isaac Sooty to his heirs and assigns to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with all and singular the rights appurtenant thereto whatsoever to the said bargain purchase his heirs and assigns or anyone appearing with the appurtenances unto the same and to the heirs and assigns of the said Sooty.
