for value received have bargained and sold to the said Mardith Brown the following property to wit her interest in the following described negroes it being one tenth part of the said Negroes to wit being a woman about forty two years of age named a woman about twenty four years of age Crawford a man about twenty two years of age Sis a boy about nineteen years of age like a boy about nineteen years of age Mary a girl about fifteen years of age Matilda a girl about five years of age Washington a boy about three years of age

To have and to hold the aforesaid bargained property to him the said Mardith Brown his heirs and assigns forever I the said Saia Mary Howard for myself my heirs executors and administrators the said property unto the said Mardith Brown his heirs and assigns against me my executors & administrators and against all and every other person and persons whatever shall and will warrant and defend by these presents

Provided nevertheless that if the said Mary Howard her heirs executors and administrators shall do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Mardith Brown his heirs and assigns the aforesaid sum of one hundred and six dollars and 82 cents the day mentioned & appointed for the payment thereof in said promissory note mentioned according to the tenor of said note then and from thenceforth as well this bill of sale and the right to the property hereby conveyed as the said promissory note shall cease & determine and to be void to all intents and purposes In testimony whereof the said Saia Mary Howard hath signed at her hand and affixed her seal this the twenty fifth day of December eighteen hundred forty three Sealed & delivered in presence of
