Georgia. This Indisitute made this twenty eighth day of February  
De Kalb County in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
forty four Between Miles G. Robinson of said County of the one part and  
the Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company of the other part witness  
that the said Robinson for and in consideration of running their  
contemplated Rail Road on and along his land as well as in  
consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid at  
and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained  
and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and  
sell unto the said Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company and  
their successors and assigns the right of way over which to pass  
at all times by themselves directors officers agents hirelings and  
servants in any manner they may think proper and particularly  
for the purpose of running erecting and establishing  
thereon a Rail Road with the requisite number of tracts pursuant  
to a charter of incorporation passed the twenty first day  
of December eighteen hundred and thirty three and am-  
plified at subsequent sessions of the general Assembly by  
conferring Banking powers and the privilege of extending the  
road from Madison to the southern terminus of the Western &  
Atlantic Rail Road & to this end the limit of said right  
of way shall extend in width thirty three yards on each  
side of the center line of the road way of the said Rail Road  
when completed, and to extend in length through the whole  
tract of land owned and claimed by said Robinson it  
being lot No 14 in the 14<sup>th</sup> district originally Henry county now  
De Kalb county adjoining lands of William Thurman and  
others and running in such direction through said tract of  
land as the said Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company by  
their Engineers shall think best suited for the purpose of loca-  
ting and establishing their works, and connected with said  
right of way the said company shall have the right to cut down  
and remove all such trees underwood and other growth  
and timber of each side of said road as would by falling  
or shaking the same injure the rails or other parts of the  
road, In addition to the other strips of land the said Robinson  
also conveys to the said company all that part of said lot  
so fourteen laying south of the Rail Road in consideration  
of the sum of three dollars per acre to be paid to him as  
soon as the same is surveyed including the strip first  
described, Together with all and singular the right members and  
appurtenances to the said strip tract or parcel of land being ad-  
joining or in any wise appertaining and more especially the  
right of way over the same To have and to hold the same unto  
the said Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company their suc-  
cessors and assigns to their own proper use here after  
behalf forever in fee simple upon payment and it is  
nearly understood that should the said Rail Road be  
erected as a forward and not located and established

along said strip tract or parcel of land described in the above  
and foregoing indenture, then said indenture is to be wholly null  
and void and of no effect. And the said Robinson for himself  
his heirs and assigns will warrant and defend the title thereto  
unto the Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company their successors  
and assigns against the claims of all persons whatsoever,  
the witness whereof the said Wiles G. Robinson hath hereunto  
set his hand and seal the day and year first aforesaid written,

Company of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Joseph S. M. Pat-  
terson for and in consideration of running their contemplated  
Rail Road on and along his land as well as in consideration  
of the sum of one Dollar to him in hand paid at and before the  
sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is fully  
acknowledged hath given granted bargained and sold and  
by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said  
Georgia Rail Road & Banking Company and their successors  
and assigns the right of way over which to pass at all times by  
themselves Directors officers agents hirelings and servants in  
any manner they may think proper and particularly for the  
purpose of running creating and establishing thereon a  
Rail Road with the requisite number of tracks pursuant to a  
charter of incorporation passed the twenty first day of December  
Eighteen hundred and thirty three and amended at subsequent sessions  
of the General Assembly by conferring Banking powers and the  
privilege of extending the road from Madison to the southern termi-  
nus of the Western & Atlantic Rail Road and to this end the limit  
of said right of way shall extend in width thirty three and one  
third (33 1/3) yards on each side of the center line of the road way  
of the said Rail Road when completed and to extend in length  
through the whole tract of land owned and claimed by said  
Joseph S. M. Patterson situated lying and being in DeKalb County  
adjoining lands of Alasdair Barr and others and running  
in such direction through said tract of land as the said Georgia
