to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and do by these presents
grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Lemuel Dean
his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate
lying and being in the County of Dekalb and in the fifth
district of said County and known in the plan of said
district by the number Two hundred and fifty three acres
containing two hundred two and a half acres more or less
to have and to hold said tract or parcel of land unto him the
said Lemuel Dean his heirs and assigns together with all
and singular the rights members and appurtenances
thereof to the same in any manner belonging to him and
their own proper use benefit and behoof forever in fee

and administrators & against all & every other person &
persons whatsoever shall & will warrant & defend by
these presents in Witness whereof we have hereunto
