bargain, sell, alien and convey, as far as his authority as Administrator
as aforesaid will warrant him, unto the said John J. Thrasher

District of Originally Murray but now Dekalb County known and
distinguished in the Plan of said District by Number One hundred
and Ninety eight, Containing Two hundred two and a half acres,
agreeable to Original Survey by the same more or less with all
