DeKalb County } State and County for and in consideration of the natural love
and affection which I have and bear to my sons Allan & Ephraim
& Poole of the same place and for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars
Cash in hand paid by the said Allan & Poole the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
do by these presents give and grant unto my said son Allan & Poole in trust
for the said Ephraim M Poole & for the use & benefit of said Ephraim during
his natural life the five following Negroes to wit: Maria a woman
about thirty eight years old of yellow complexion and her four children
to wit: Green a boy about ten years old of yellow complexion & John a boy
about eight years old of yellow complexion & Alexander a boy about
six years old of yellow complexion and Mary Jane a girl child about
six months old of yellow complexion and at the death of said
Ephraim M Poole I give and grant to the children of said Ephraim
M Poole all of said Negroes and their increase to be equally divided
amongst them and in case the said Ephraim M Poole should depart this
life without leaving any children then said Negroes & their increase
are to revert to my estate In testimony whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this the 10th day of April
1845 Signed sealed and delivered

Georgia } This Indenture made and entered into
DeKalb County } this first day of June in the year of
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four between
Noah Hornby of the County and State aforesaid of the one part
and the Deacons or Drivers of the primitive Methodist Church
at Camp Creek in said State and County and their successors
in office for the use of said Church of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Noah Hornby for and in
consideration of the sum of fifteen (15) dollars to him
in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these
presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
granted bargain and sell and by these presents do
grant bargain sell and convey unto the said
Deacons of said Church and their successors

for the use of said Church and then all that tract or parcel of land it being a part of lot one hundred and twenty four situated lying and being in the fourth District of formerly known now DeKalb County known and distinguished in the place of said District by the above named lot one hundred and twenty four it being part of said lot one the west line whereon the Meeting House now stands commencing on the west line at the Santa road near the Grave yard thence up the said road one hundred and fifty three yards to a post oak thence to the branch one hundred and fifty four yards to a double history thence across the branch fifty yards to a bunch of Willows in the Swamp on or near the west line including the Spring thence on the west line Southward to the beginning corner containing there are to the same more or less with all and singular the rights liberties and appurtenances thereto or in anywise belonging to said parcel of land to him the said Deacon or Deacons of said Church and their Successors in office for the use of said Church

To have and to hold the said parcel of land unto the said Deacon or Deacons of said Church and their Successors in office for the use of said Church the right and title of which parcel of land I do from warrant & assent unto him the said Deacon or Deacons of said Church and their Successors in office for the use of said Church against my own right or the right title or claim of any other person or persons whatsoever so long as there remains a Baptist Church of the primitive Order at that place or on that parcel or piece of land but whenever the primitive Baptist Church at that place departs or removes off of said parcel of land or connects herself with any of the institutions of the day called Missionary said parcel of land together with the appurtenances shall revert back to the proper owner of said lot in testimony whereof I the said Noah Hornsby have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal this day and date above written signed sealed and delivered in presence of us
