DeKalb County Lyon of Perry County Alabama am held and
firmly bound unto James Farwell & his wife Elizabeth Farwell
in the sum of six hundred dollars to the true payment of which
I bind myself my heirs executors administrators & assigns firmly
by these presents sealed with my seal and dated this 15th day of
March 1844 The condition of the above bond is such that whereas
said James Farwell & Elizabeth Farwell his wife have agreed that
said Noah Lyon shall and may possess himself of \$1000 &
enjoy the following slaves during the lifetime of said Elizabeth
Farwell to witn Henry Sam Brown & Jacob in consideration that
he the said Noah Lyon will pay them the said slaves to
Elizabeth his wife the sum of three hundred dollars annually
for & during the life of the said Elizabeth Farwell said sum
to be paid on the first day of April in each and every year
during the life of said Elizabeth Farwell Now if the said Noah
Lyon shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the
said James Farwell & Elizabeth Farwell his wife the sum of
Three hundred dollars in each and every year during the life of
said Elizabeth on the first day of April in each and every year
commencing on the first day of April in the year eighteen
hundred and forty five then the above bond to be paid or else
to remain in full force & virtue aforesaid signed sealed and delivered
on the day & year aforesaid in
