Known all men by these presents that I Noah Lyon of Perry County Alabama am held and firmly bound unto James Farrell & his wife Elizabeth Farrell in the sum of six hundred dollars to the true payment of which I bind myself my heirs executors administrators & assigns firmly by these presents sealed with my seal and dated this 15th day of March 1844. The condition of the above bond is such that whereas said James Farrell & Elizabeth Farrell his wife have agreed that said Noah Lyon shall and may possess himself of 4 men & enjoy the following slaves during the lifetime of said Elizabeth Farrell to wit Mary Jane Vinney & Jacob in consideration that he the said Noah Lyon will pay them the said sum of \$300 & Elizabeth his wife the sum of Three Hundred dollars annually for & during the life of the said Elizabeth Farrell said sum to be paid on the first day of April in each and every year during the life of said Elizabeth Farrell. Now if the said Noah Lyon shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said James Farrell & Elizabeth Farrell his wife the sum of Three hundred dollars in each and every year during the life of said Elizabeth on the first day of April in each and every year commencing on the first day of April in the year eighteen hundred and forty five then the above bond to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue Signed Sealed and delivered on the day & year aforesaid in presence of
