Tilly of the State aforesaid and County of aforesaid of the other party witnesseth that the said Ruellie Com for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and thirty Dollars to him in hand paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents to the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and doth by these presents to grant bargain sell and convey unto the said John W. Tilly his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of originally being now Dekalb County said lot or parcel of land is known and distinguished in the plan of the Eighteenth District aforesaid by Number two hundred and forty three 243 containing six hundred two and a half acres more or less.

To have and to hold a tract or parcel of land and from the said John W. Tilly his heirs and assigns together with all and singular the rights, members & appurtenances thereto to the same in every manner belonging to him & his own proper use benefit and behoof forever in fee simple. And the said Ruellie Com for himself his heirs executors and administrators the said bargained premises unto the said John W. Tilly his heirs and assigns will warrant and defend the right and title thereof against themselves and against the claim of all other persons whatever. half of lot Number fifty nine 69 in the Sixteenth

one hundred six and one fourth acres more or less its
