forty eight and in the fifty third year of the Independence of the
United States of America between Elisha Bramwell of the
County of Clark of the one part and Thomas Kennedy of the County
of DeKalb of the other part witnesseth that the said Elisha
Bramwell for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred
and fifty dollars in hand paid at and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledged hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and
confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien-
eage and confirm unto the said Thomas Kennedy his heirs and
affixes all that tract or parcel of Land situate lying and be-
ing in the 14th fourteen of originally Fayette now DeKalb
County Georgia and distinguished in the Plan of said dis-
trict by the Number (9) Nine containing two hundred two
and a half acres more or less To have and to hold the said
tract or parcel of land with all and singular the rights and
privileges and appurtenances therof whatsoever to the said tract or
parcel of land being belonging or in any wise appertaining to
the remainder and remainder reversion and occasions rents
issues and profits thereof to the only proper use benefit and
behalf of him the said Thomas Kennedy his heirs executors
administrators and affixes in fee simple and the said Elisha
Bramwell his heirs executors and administrators the said
bargained premises unto the said Thomas Kennedy his heirs
executors and administrators and affixes against the said
Elisha Bramwell his heirs executors and Administrators
and all and every other person or persons shall and will
forever warrant and defend by virtue of these presents
