Frederick A. Williams his heirs and assigns his interest
the same being one half of in and to all those tracts or
parcels of land situate lying and being in the County of
DeKalb known and distinguished as Lot Number Seventeen
containing two hundred and two and one half acres
more or less Lot Number twenty two containing two
hundred and two and one half acres more or less
Lot Number eighteen containing one hundred and
fifty six acres more or less Lot Number twenty containing
twenty six and one half acres more or less Lot Number
twenty one containing one hundred and ninety five
acres more or less each and every one of the aforesaid
lots lying and being in the fourth and the District of
originally Fayette but now DeKalb County.

together with all and singular the rights liberties and
appurtenances thereof to the same in any manner belonging
to his and their own proper use benefit and behoof

the right and title thereof against themselves and
against the claim of All other persons whatsoever.

Connally his heirs & assigns to his & their own proper use benefit & behoof forever & the said Robert Brachman for himself his heirs Executors administrators trustees & assigns promises or property unto the said C. M. Connally with warrant & force against the claim of himself & his heirs & against the claim of all other persons whatever. Pronounce & testify that if the said Robert Brachman his heirs Executors & administrators shall do well & truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said C. M. Connally his heirs & assigns the aforementioned sum of fifty dollars on the day and time mentioned & appointed for the payment thereof in the said promissory note mentioned in the lawful interest for the same according to the tenor of said note then and from thence forth as well this present indenture and the right to the property thereby conveyed as the said promissory note shall cease determine and be void to all intents and purposes in testimony whereof the said Robert Brachman hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written signed sealed & delivered in presence of
