and assigns all that tract or parcel of Land. Situate lying and
being in Originally Henry Now DeKalb County being one half of Lot
number One Hundred and fourteen in the Fifth South District of
said County. Together with all and singular the Rights Members and
Appurtenances thereto whatsoever to the said tract or portion of Land
being belonging or in any wise appertaining and the Remainder here-
unto by Right Title and Profit thereof and every part thereof to
have and to hold the said tract or portion of Land and
all and singular the premises and Appurtenances thereto belonging
as aforesaid and every part thereof unto the said Samuel Morris
his heirs and assigns forever and the said Robert Jones and
his heirs the said tract or portion of Land and premises aforesaid
and every part thereof unto the said Samuel Morris his heirs

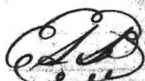

That the said Robert Jones for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred Dollars to him in hand well and truly paid by the said James Moore, at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, conveyed and released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, release, convey and confirm unto the said James Moore his heirs and assigns, all that tract or portion of Land, situate lying and being in originally Henry now DeKalb County, being one fourth part of Lot Number One Hundred and fifteen in the fifteenth district of said County. It being the undivided North half of said Lot. Containing William 4 acres on the North side and James Nickels on the East side being & lying on the Waters of Sugar Creek.

Together with all and singular the Right, Minors and Appurtenances thereto Whatsoever to the said tract or portion of Land being belonging or in anywise appertaining.
