truly pay or cause to be paid to the said Ephraim Mason  
his heirs or assigns the sum of money in the said promissory  
note above specified on or by the term the said promissory  
note becomes due then this indenture as well as the said  
promissory note shall cease to be void and of no effect otherwise  
to remain in full force and virtue In testimony whereof
