Georgia 3. Whereas in obedience to a writ of Profacias issued out
of the Superior Court of the County of DeKalb at the Suit of
Robert Simpson against John Simpson and Leonard Simpson
John Jones Sheriff of the County aforesaid did lately seize the lots or
parcels of land & premises hereinafter described as the property of the said
John Simpson and after being duly and publicly advertised agreeably
to Law did on the Seventh day of July Eighteen hundred and forty
at the place of public sale in the said County of DeKalb expose
the same at public outcry when Charles Murphy being the high-
est bidder the same was knocked off to him at the price or
sum of Fifty dollars

Now this indenture made the tenth day of July in the year of our Lord
one thousand Eight hundred and forty one and in the 65th year
of the Independence of the United States of America between the
said John Jones Sheriff as aforesaid of the one part and the
said Charles of the County of DeKalb of the other part Notwith-
standing that the said John Jones Sheriff as aforesaid for and in
consideration of the sum of Fifty dollars to him in hand paid
by the said Charles Murphy at and before the sealing and
delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged hath granted and bargained and sold and by these
presents doth grant bargain and sell so far as the office of
Sheriff authorizes him unto the said Charles Murphy his
heirs and assigns all that lot or parcel of land situate in the
Town of Decatur in said County known and distinguished
in the plan of said Town as Lot Number thirty Six and
also the ^{West} side of Lot Number thirty seven in said Town of
Decatur to wit Sixteen feet wide in front of said lot fronting
the square in said Town commencing at the South West
corner of said lot Number thirty seven and running
due East Sixteen feet thence due North to the back
line of said lot Number thirty seven thence due west to
the corner of said lot then a straight line to the high-
way corner together with all and singular the rights
members and appurtenances thereof unto the said parcel
of land being belonging or in any wise appertaining and
also all the estate right title interest property claims
and demands of the said John Simpson his heirs
and assigns in and to the said parcels of land with
equity or otherwise whatsoever of in or to the same
and to hold the said lots & parcels of

and every part thereof unto the said Charles Murphy his
heirs and assigns to the only proper use benefit and behoof of
the said Charles Murphy his heirs and assigns forever
in fee simple in as free and ample a manner as
the said John Simpson or his heirs and assigns did or

DeKalb County in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and forty two between Richard Head Sr of the
County and state aforesaid of the one part and the Primitive
Baptist Church of Christ known by the name of Primitive Cool
Spring Church of the same place of the other part witnesseth that
the said Head for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar
to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivering of these
presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bar-
gained sold and conveyed and by these presents doth grant
bargain sell and convey unto the members of the above named
Church at Primitive Cool Spring a piece of Land containing two
acres including the present Meeting house the said piece of Land
to be in a square form also to have free privilege and access to make
use of his the said Heads on Lot 40 (40) forty lying and being in the
fourteenth district of originally Henry now DeKalb County to have
and to hold said piece of land so long as they may see fit to
keep a church on said piece of land and retains the fact that they
now hold to which faith is the indestinarian faith and whenever
the said Church shall or may remove from said piece of Land
then the land to be the property of the owner of the above named
Lot together with all and singular the right members and appur-
tenances thereof to the only proper use benefit and behoof of said
Church in fee simple and the said Richard Head Sr do warrant
and forever defend the said piece of land to the said Church from
any person or persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part
