Georgia 1842 Between James Heagerty on the one part
and James H Kirkpatrick of the other part witnesseth that
the said James Heagerty for and in consideration of the sum
of one hundred and Ninety two dollars and Eighteen cents to
him in hand paid of and for which he said Heagerty has
given his Notes dated the 22nd for said sum of \$172.16 now
due has this day bargained and sold and delivered to said
James H Kirkpatrick the lot of land wherein the said Heagerty
is now living joined John Thirman joining Joseph Pitts
Harris and others Simmons Run (to be set down when
known) which lot of land I have this day bar-
gained Sold and delivered to James H Kirkpatrick and for
ever will defend the same to the said Kirkpatrick with
all that appertains to said lot of land to him his heirs or
affirs and I do further sell one young steer four years
old with one瞎 eye also Seven head of horned cattle
to wit two Milk cows three heifers two years old two of
calves also two feather beds bedsteads and furniture also
eight fancy chairs with clock and looking glass with
two tables one a folding top also two chests and a trunk
also one oil road cart all said property I have this day
sold to said H Kirkpatrick he letting me have the use of
said property and land for a term of six years at a rent
of Sixty dollars a year and said Kirkpatrick agrees
that if the said Heagerty does within the time of two
years from the 25th of December next pay or cause to
be paid to the said James H Kirkpatrick the sum of Two
hundred dollars with lawful interest from thine date
then the above contract to be void and of no effect but
otherwise if said two hundred dollars is not paid by
the 25th of December 1844 then all right of redemption is
lost for ever as witness my hand and seal date above



and sold and do by these presents grant bargain and sell
unto the said Cornelius Mc Connally his heirs and assigns all
that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the
fourteenth district of originally Henry now DeKalb County
Kirby and distinguished in the place of district by the
west half of lot number eighty nine (89) containing one
hundred one and a fourth acres more or less. To have and to
hold the said bargained tract or parcel of land with all and
