Articles of agreement between Robert Watkins of the one
part and Polly Haygood of the other part. Witness that the
said Robert Watkins and Polly Haygood is about to
Contract and join themselves together in the holy estate of
matrimony and that one agreed for each one of us to
keep their own property to dispose of at their own option
if any property be made after marriage it is to be given
to dispose of as we may think best. In Witness of the same
we have set our names and affix our seals this date
above written.

State of Georgia This Indenture made this 25th
day of September in the year of our Lord
One thousand Eight hundred and thirty nine
between Charles A. Denton of the County and State aforesaid
of the one part and Polly Haygood of the County &
County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witness
that the said Charles A. Denton for and in consideration of
the sum of four hundred and twenty dollars to him
in hand paid at and before the signing and delivery
thereof. The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged -
have granted bargained sold and conveyed unto the said
Polly Haygood her heirs and assigns all that tract
or parcels of Land Situate lying and being in the
County of DeKalb formerly Mary and Thomas and
distincted in the plan of the District of said
County of Mary as Lot No. Two hundred and thirty nine
(239) and granted to Edmund Stahn the 20th of October 1825
to have and to hold the said tract or parcels of Land unto
her the said Polly Haygood her heirs and assigns together with
all and singular the rights member and appurtenances
thereof to the same in any manner belonging to her their
own proper use benefit and behoof in fee simple forever
And the said Charles A. Denton for himself his heirs
executors & administrators the bargained premises unto the said
Polly Haygood her heirs and assigns with covenant
warrant defend the right and title thereof against themselves
and against the claims of all the persons whatsoever
by Whomsoever the said Charles A. Denton hath
conveyed let his hand and seal this day and year
above written
