 Gordon of the other part, Witnesseth that the said John Brown Sheriff as  
 aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to him  
 in hand paid by the said Pew Gordon at and before the sealing and  
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged in  
 written, bargained, and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain  
 and sell, so far as the office of Sheriff authorizes him, unto the said  
 Pew Gordon his heirs and assigns all that Parcel of land to wit the  
 thirds of Lot of Land No sixteen in the sixteen th district of originally  
 Henry now DeKalb County, Together with all and singular the rights  
 members and appurtenances there of unto the said Parcel of land being  
 belonging or in any wise appertaining, and also all the estate right title  
 interest property claim and demand of the said Pew Gordon in law  
 equity or otherwise whatsoever of in or to the same, To have and to hold  
 the said parcel of land and premises and every part thereof unto the  
 said Pew Gordon his heirs and assigns to the only proper use benefit  
 and behoof of the said Pew Gordon his heirs and assigns forever in  
 fee simple in as full and ample a manner as the said Green  
 Boling or his heirs and assigns did or might have held and enjoyed  
 the same had it not been seized and sold under the execution of
