

Georgia This Indenture made this tenth day of September by
DeKalb County, one hundred and thirty six between G B Lanier of
the one part and Jas Stubb of the other part both of the said
and County aforesaid witnesseth that the said G B Lanier for
and in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars
to him advanced paid at and before the sealing and delivery of
these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath
granted bargained sold and conveyed and doth by these presents
grant bargain sell and convey unto the said J Stubb his
heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situated lying
and being in the County aforesaid but on the County of DeKalb
at the time of Survey known and distinguished by lot No 100 ten
in the fifteenth District containing two hundred two and
a half acres more or less originally granted to Sarah Owen
bounded by John Mitchel on the east.

I have and to hold said tract or parcel of land unto him
the said James Stubb his heirs and assigns together with all and
singular the rights members and appurtenances thereof to the
same in any manner belonging to his and their own properne
benefit and behoef forever in fee simple and the said G B Lanier for
himself his heirs and assigns administrator the said bargain
premises unto the said J Stubb his heirs and assigns will warrant
and forever defend the right and title thereof against themselves
and the claim of all other persons whatever be witnesseth
the said G B Lanier hath hereunto set his hand and seal the
