conveyed, and conveyed, and by these presents do grant bargain
sell alien convey and confirm unto the said James T. Wright
his heirs and assigns. All that Lot or Tract of Land con-
taining One hundred and one and a half acres, More or less,
lying the North East half of the North East corner of the
Eighteenth District of the County of DeKalb, Georgia, more or less,
beginning at the North West corner of said
lot, running east Eighteen poles, thence crossing on a straight
line from thence to poles to a corner on a black oak, thence

 said Silas McGrady the one half of Lot No 193 lying
 in the 18th District of originally Henry County De Kalb
 County known and designated in the plan
 of said District, beginning at the Northwest corner
 of said Lot running East Eighty poles thence
 Cornway on a stake from Thence County five
 poles to corner Black Oak. South to the corner
 line bounded by McGrady & Lindy thence
 taking said line through said land that is the
 South East corner thence this including all
 the land lying on the North East side of
 the aforesaid line of said Lot it being by
