 to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these
 presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted
 bargained sold and conveyed and do by these presents grant bargain
 sell and convey unto the said Mrs. Mason, heirs and assigns
 all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the
 County of originally Henry now DeKalb in said State known
 and distinguished by the North half of lot Number one hundred
 and thirteen (113) in the Eighteenth district containing one
 hundred one and one fourth acres be the same more or less
 To have and to hold said tract or parcel of land unto him the
 said William F. Mason his heirs and assigns together with
 all and singular the rights members and appurtenances
 thereof to the same in any manner belonging to his and their
 own proper use benefit and behoof forever in fee simple
 and the said Ezekiel Mason for himself his heirs executors
 and administrators the said bargained premises unto the
 said Mrs. Mason his heirs and assigns will warrant and
 forever defend the right and title thereof against themselves and
 against the claim of all other persons whatever In testimony

these presents doth grant bargain sell & convey unto the said Lucius
& Wittich his heirs & assigns all that tract or parcel of ground
lying & being in the State aforesaid & County of DeKalb (formerly
Henry) in the Eighteenth district of (said Henry formerly) containing
two hundred two & a half acres more or less & known as Number
Two hundred & fifty five in said District To have & to hold
said bargained land together with all & singular the rights &
appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining
unto the said Lucius L. Wittich his heirs and assigns forever
in fee simple And the said Stephen Boothe for himself his
heirs executors & administrators & assigns the said bargained
lot of land unto the said Lucius L. Wittich his heirs & assigns execu-
tors & assigns administrators will warrant & forever defend against
the claim of the said Stephen Boothe his heirs & assigns & of all other
