 between John Byer of said County of the one part and
 the Georgia Rail Road Banking Company of the other
 part witnesses that the said John Byer for and in
 consideration of summing their contemplated Rail Road
 on and along his land as well as in consideration
 of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid at and
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain
 and sold unto the said Georgia Rail Road Banking Com-
 pany their Executors & assigns the right of way over which
 to pass at all times by their said Directors Officers agents
 servants and servants in in any manner they may think
 proper and particularly for the purpose of erecting and establishing
 through a rail road with the requisite number of tracks pursuant to a
 Charter of Incorporation passed the twenty first day of December eighteen
 hundred and thirty three and amended at subsequent Sessions of the General
 Assembly by conferring Banking powers and the privilege of extending the
 said Rail Road from Madison to the Southern terminus of the Western and
 North Rail Road and to this end the limit of said right of
 way shall extend in width thirty three yards on
 each side of the Road less of the said Rail Road
