March in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
and thirty one and in the fifty fourth year of the Independence
of the United States of America between the Justices of the Superior
Court of the County of DeKalb of the one part and Thomas Stearns
of the County of DeKalb of the other part Witnesseth that the said
Justices of the Superior Court for and in consideration of the
Sum of four hundred dollars to them in hand paid at and
before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed
and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell
alien convey and confirm unto the said Thomas Stearns his
heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of Land lying being
and situate in the Town of Decatur in the County aforesaid
known and distinguished in the plan of said Town by number
one hundred & forty three containing eight acres more or less
to have and to hold the said bargained premises with all and
singular the rights members and appurtenances thereof
whosoever to the said premises being belonging or in anywise
appertaining with the remainder and remainders therein
and reversionary rents issues and profits thereof to the only
proper use benefit and behoof of him the said Thomas Stearns
his heirs executors administrators and assigns in fee simple
and the said Justices of the Superior Court the said bargained
premises unto the said Thomas Stearns his heirs executors ad-
ministrators and assigns against the said Justices of the Superior
Court & against all and every other person or persons shall
and will warrant and forever defend by virtue of these
presents In Witness whereof the said Justices of the Superior Court
hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day
