in the sixteenth district of originally Henry now DeKalb County, known and
distinguished in the plan of said district by the number sixteen (16) it being
the undivided one sixth part of said lot, lot containing thirty three and two
third acres more or less, To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land
with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances thereto
belonging or in any wise appertaining to the only proper use benefit and
use of the said Charles Latimer his heirs and assigns forever in fee

Georgia This Indenture made this the fourth day of October in the year of DeKalb County, our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty three between Edward Howard of the one part and Semmes Huley of the other part both of the county and state aforesaid; Witnesseth that the said Edward Howard for me in consideration of the sum of fifteen thousand dollars in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained sold alienated conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alientate convey and confirm unto the said Semmes Huley his heirs and assigns all that tract or lots of land situated lying and being in the County and State aforesaid and known by Lots No(17) forty seven and also the remaining parts of lots (17) seventeen and (18) forty eight all containing four hundred and five acres more or less, lying and being in the sixteenth district of originally DeCatur but now DeKalb County and State aforesaid lying on the North east side of the South Oakmudga river to have and to hold the said lots or parcels of land unto the aforesaid Semmes Huley his heirs and assigns Executors administrators and devisees for myself my heirs and assigns Executors administrators and all other persons whatever claiming the same and will forever warrant and defend the right and title of the aforesaid parcels of land in fee simple the witness whereof I have set my and affixed my seal the day and date above written. Georgia This Indenture made this seventeenth day of February in the DeKalb County year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty four between John Bird of the one part and Semmes Huley both of the State and County aforesaid of the other part; Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars to him in hand before the sealing and delivering these present the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained sold and conveyed unto the said Semmes Huley a certain tract of Land in the County aforesaid on South river and the same in the plan of the fifteenth district of originally DeCatur but now DeKalb by the number fifty nine (59), it being the north half of said lot, beginning with all the eight members and appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Semmes Huley his heirs and assigns to have and to hold the same in fee simple and the said John Bird with body went and gave up and released all claim and title to the same to the said Semmes Huley his heirs and assigns.
