of DeKalb at the suit of Thomas A. Sullivan & Co against
Willis M. Cash and Moses Murphy & John W. Fowler
Sheriff of the County of DeKalb did lately seize the parcel of
land hereinafter described as the property of the said Willis
M. Cash and after the same being duly advertised agreeably to
law did on the third day of March in the year eighteen
hundred and forty at the place of public sales in the said
County of DeKalb expose the same at public outcry when
Ezchiel Mason being the highest bidder the same was known
off to him at the price or sum of Eighty one dollars

Now this deed made the Twenty fifth day of January
in the year eighteen hundred and forty four between the said
John W. Fowler Sheriff as aforesaid of the one part and the said
Ezchiel Mason of the other part witnesseth that the said
John W. Fowler Sheriff as aforesaid for and in consideration of
the sum of Eighty one dollars to him in hand paid by the
said Ezchiel Mason at and before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents with
grant bargain sell and convey so far as the office of Sheriff
authorizes him unto the said Ezchiel Mason his heirs and
assigns all that tract or half lot of land situate lying and
being in the Eighteenth (18) district of originally Henry
now DeKalb County containing one hundred one and one
fourth acres more or less known and distinguished in the
plan of said district by the North half of Lot No 146 one
hundred and forty six together with all and singular the
rights members and appurtenances thereto and also all the estate
right title interest claim and demand of the said Willis
Cash in law equity or otherwise whatsoever of in or to the same
to have and to hold the said premises and every part thereof unto
the said Ezchiel Mason his heirs and assigns in as full and
ample a manner as the said Willis M. Cash or his heirs and
assigns did hold and enjoy or might have held and enjoyed
the same had it not been seized and sold under the execution
aforesaid
