have for and in consideration of the sum of one
hundred dollars to me in hand paid the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged bargained and sold
and do by these presents bargain sell alien and con-
vey unto David Montgomery of the same place a
certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in
the seventeenth District of originally Henry now
supposed to be DeKalb County in the plan of said
District by Lot Number Sixty (60) containing One
hundred two and a half acres more or less which
said lot or tract of Land together with all and
singular the rights Members and appertaining
thereto being belonging upon any time ap-
pearing to the said Thomas W Harris so warrant
and as against the claim of myself

my heirs executors Administrators and assigns and against
the claim or claims of all and every other person or persons
whatsoever unto him the said David Montgomery to
have and to hold the said tract of land and bargained
precises unto himself his heirs executors Administrators
and assigns forever for their own proper use benefit and
behalf in fee simple in testimony whereof he the
said Thomas W Morris hath hereunto set his hand & affixed
his seal the day and date above written signed sealed
and delivered in the presence of

firm unto the said William A David his heirs and assigns
all that tract or parcel of land situate on the South side
the Nelson Ferry Road and bounded on the North by said road
said land is situate and is a part of Number Two hun
dred and ~~thirty~~ fifty (250) and adjoining the town of Decatur
Said parcel of land containing one and a half acres
more or less and is bounded all around by a plant
being the same place where the said James W Mc Dow
now resides. To have and to hold the said parcel of
land with all and singular the rights members and
servitudes thereto appertaining to the only proper
benefit and behoof of him the said William A David his
heirs executors Administrators the said bargained premises
