 and County aforesaid witnesseth that the said S. B. Lavier for  
 and in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred dollars  
 to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of  
 these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath  
 granted bargained sold and conveyed and do by these presents  
 grant bargain sell and convey unto the said J. S. Stubbs his  
 heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of land situated lying  
 and being in the County aforesaid but in the County of Henry  
 at the time of survey known and distinguished by lot No. 115) ten  
 in the fifteenth district containing two hundred two and  
 a half acres more or less originally granted to Sarah Owen  
 bounded by John Mitchell on the east  
 to have and to hold said tract or parcel of land unto him  
 the said James S. Stubbs his heirs and assigns together with all and  
 singular the rights members and appurtenances thereof to the  
 same in any manner belonging to his and their own proper use  
 benefit and behoof forever in fee simple and the said S. B. Lavier for  
 himself his heirs and assigns administrator the said bargain  
 premises unto the said J. S. Stubbs his heirs and assigns will warrant  
 and forever defend the right and title thereof against themselves  
 and the claim of all other persons whatever In witness whereof

 these presents do grant bargain and sell so far as the office  
 Sheriff authorizes him unto the said G. W. Lewis his heirs and  
 assigns all that tract of land situate lying and being in the seven-  
 teenth district of originally Henry now DeKalb County and  
 known in the plan of said district by number Seventy  
 containing two hundred two and a half acres more or  
 less with all the rights members appurtenances to said lot of  
 land in any wise appertaining or belonging and also all the
