

This Indenture made on the twenty sixth day of February in the year Eighteen hundred and forty two Between Thomas McKaffey of the County of Georgia and County of DeKalb of the one part and James Smith of the same State and County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas McKaffey hath for and in consideration of the sum of fifty five dollars to him in hand paid by the said James Smith the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and conveyed and do by these presents bargain sell and convey unto the said James Smith Eleven Acres of land it being a part of lot two hundred and twenty four in the fifteenth district of Henry formerly now DeKalb drawn by Philip Cook of said County lying the South east corner of said lot beginning by two rods thence South westerly Rod to the South line thence East twenty two rods to the beginning corner to the said Smith & his heirs and assigns forever in fee simple and for myself I will well and truly warrant and forever defend against myself my heirs and all and every other person or persons claiming the same or any part thereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day and year above written done in the presence of

Georgia This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of November Eighteen hundred and forty two between Wilson & McBea of the State and County aforesaid of the one part and John L. Evans of the same place of the other part Witnesseth that the said Wilson & McBea for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred dollars to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and does by these presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said John L. Evans his heirs and assigns all that parcel of land contained in the following bounds and situate in the seventeenth district of Henry now DeKalb County (Ga.) beginning at a creek where the west line of No. (41) forty one crosses and thence North along said line to the corner and thence East to my corner and then South along the east line of said lot (41) to a hickory corner agreed upon by the parties and thence in a straight line to the branch of Shoat Branch to a cucumber corner and thence down said Runway creek to the beginning place known in the plan of said district by name of one containing one hundred and fifty acres or less to have and to hold

him the said John L Evans his heirs and assigns to-
gether with all and singular the rights members and
appurtenances thereof to the same in any manner belong-
ing to him and their own proper use benefit and behoof
forever in fee simple and the said Wilson & Mc Kee
for himself his heirs executors and administrators the
said bargained premises unto the said John L Evans his
heirs and assigns well warrant and forever defend the
right and title thereof against themselves and against

by the said Henry Dixon before the sealing and delivering
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
edged hath bargained sold conveyed & confirmed unto him
the said Henry Dixon his heirs executors administrators &c
and by these presents do sell convey and confirm unto
him the said Henry Dixon his heirs executors admin^{rs} &c
all that tract or lot of land known as lot Number Two
thousand and twenty nine (229) in the fifteenth district of
Henry at the time of survey but now DeKalb County in the
State aforesaid containing two hundred two and a half
acres be the same more or less the said land unto him the
said Henry his heirs &c to have and to hold to his own pro-
per use benefit & behoof together with all and singular the

any wise appertaining in fee simple forever and I do
hereby for myself my heirs heirs admin^{rs} &c warrant and
well defend the right and title of the said bargained
premises together with all and singular the
