Lazzard of the same place of the other part Witnesseth that  
the said William Austin for & in consideration of the  
sum of Sixty dollars to him in hand paid the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged has this day bargained sold  
conveyed & doth by these presents hath bargained sold & conveyed  
to the said William Lazzard his heirs & assigns a certain  
lot or parcel of land situate lying & being in the County  
of DeKalb known & distinguished as part of lot Number  
one hundred & seventy two in the fifteenth District of  
originally DeRuyt now DeKalb County beginning at the  
North east corner of said lot of land & running South  
along the line of said lot one hundred rod to a corner  
on said line and thence a due west course to a branch  
on said lot thence up the run of said branch to the  
north line of said lot and thence East along the said  
line to the beginning corner supposed to contain  
fifteen acres be the same more or less so have and  
to hold said parcel of land together with all & singular  
the rights members & appendances thereof to the

tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in  
the County of aforesaid and is situate in the fifth  
District of the same and is a tract of number  
two hundred and forty five (245) containing therights  
of a acre being that moiety or parcel of land inclose  
whereon the said Sam'ly now resides or the same more  
or less to have and to hold said tract or parcel of  
land unto him the said Sam'ly Pinaly his heirs and  
assigns together with all and singular the rights, humours  
and appurtenances thereto to the same in any manner  
belonging to him and his own proper use benefit and  
behalf forever in fee simple and the said Ruben Brown
