Walton County: number in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and forty five between William Armistead of  
the county and State of Georgia of the one part and George  
Malcolm of the same place witnesseth that the said William  
Armistead hath this day made and delivered to the said  
George Malcolm his certain promissory note subscribed  
with his hand and bearing even date with these presents  
whereby the said William Armistead hath promised to  
pay the said George Malcolm or bearer one hundred  
and Ninety five dollars  $\frac{4}{100}$ cts on or before the twenty  
fifth of December eighteen hundred forty three for value  
received more or less in consideration of the sum of  
one hundred and Ninety five dollars by the said George Malcolm to the said  
William Armistead in hand paid the receipt whereof is  
hereby acknowledged as well as for the better securing the  
payment of the for said promissory note the said William  
Armistead hath granted bargain and sold and doth by  
these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said George  
Malcolm his heirs and assigns all that tract or lot of land  
situate lying and being in the fourteenth district of formerly  
Henry now De Kalb County known and distinguished in  
the place of said district by the number eighteen containing  
two hundred two and a half acres to have and to hold  
said bargain premises to the said George Malcolm heirs and  
assigns to his and their own proper use benefit and behoof  
forever and the said William Armistead for himself his heirs  
executors and administrators the said bargained premises  
unto the said George Malcolm will warrant and forever  
defend against the claim of himself and his heirs and assigns  
the claim of himself and his heirs all other persons whatever  
ever provided nevertheless that the said William Armistead  
his heirs executors and administrators shall and do  
will truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said George  
Malcolm his heirs and assigns the aforementioned sum of  
one hundred and Ninety five dollars and  $\frac{4}{100}$ cts on the  
pay and time mentioned and appointed for the pay-  
ment thereof in the said promissory note mentioned  
with lawful interest for the same according to the  
tenor of said note then and from thenceforth as  
well this present denture and the right of the prop-  
erty thereby conveyed as the said promissory note shall  
remain determinate and be void to all intents and

ation of the sum of Three hundred dollars to him in hand  
paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bar  
gained sold and conveyed and does by these presents grant  
bargain sell and convey unto the said S Cain his heirs and  
assigns all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and  
being in the fourteenth district of originally Henry now  
DeKalb County known and distinguished in place of said  
district by the Number Ninety five containing one hun  
dred one acre a fourth acres more or less it being the north  
half of the above named lot adjoining John Lee intd other  
with all the rights members and appurtenances thereunto  
belonging do have & to hold the aforesaid parcel of  
land unto him the said S Cain his heirs and assigns  
together with all the rights members and appurtenances to  
the said parcel of land in any way belonging to his and  
their proper use benefit and behoof forever in fee simple  
and the said Thomas Henderson for himself his heirs  
executors and administrators the said bargained premises together  
with the right title and possession thereof unto the said  
S Cain his heirs and assigns will warrant and forever  
defend the right and title thereof against themselves and against
