Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of three thousand Dollars to him the said William Armstrong by the said Comely in hand paid, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the right when is hereby acknowledged, hath granted, bargained sold and conveyed and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Cornelius M Comely his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of said situate lying and being in the fourth (14) District of County formerly but now DeKalb County known and distinguished in the plan of said District by the East half of Lot Number Eighty nine (89) containing One Hundred One and a fourth Acres more or less.

to have and to hold the said bargained premises with all and singular the rights, liberties and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining unto the said Cornelius M Comely his heirs and assigns to his and their own proper use and behoof forever in fee simple and the said William Armstrong for himself his heirs executors and administrators the said bargained premises unto the said Cornelius M Comely his heirs and assigns with warrant and power defend against him and their heirs and assigns the lawful right or claim of all other persons whatsoever by virtue of their forements.
