day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and forty five (1845) Between William B. W. Dent  
by his Attorney in fact John S. Meadow of the one part  
and James B. Robertson of said State & County of the  
other part Whereas further that the said party for and in  
consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars by  
the said party of the second part in hand paid the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted  
bargain sold delivered Conveyed and Confirmed and by  
these presents do grant bargain sell alien convey &  
confirm unto the said James B. Robertson his heirs  
and assigns all that tract lot or parcel of land  
situate lying and being in the sixteenth District of  
originally Henry now Dekalb County known & distinct  
marked in the plan of said District by number eighty  
four (84) Containing two hundred two & one half acres  
more or less to have and to hold the said lot  
or parcel of land together with all and singular  
the rights & privileges and appurtenances thereto whereso  
ever to the said lot or parcel of land being belonging  
or in anywise appertaining to the only proper use  
benefit and behoof of him the said James B.  
Robertson his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns  
in fee simple and the said William B. W. Dent for  
his heirs Executors and Administrators the said bargain  
lot or parcel of land unto the said James B. Robertson  
his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns will forever  
warrant and defend against himself and his heirs  
and against the claim or claims of all and every  
other person or persons whatever In testifying  
whereof the said William B. W. Dent by his Attorney  
in fact John S. Meadow has hereunto set his hand  
to seal the day and year first above written signe
