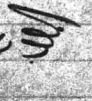

or square of land lying and being in the County of Fayette  
State aforesaid, containing two thousand two and a half acres  
identified in the Original Survey of said County & placed there  
as Lot Number Thirtysixth district Number Fourteen.

Do have and to hold the said Lot of land  
with all and singular the Rights Members and appurtenances  
thereof whatsoever to the said land, being belonging or in  
any wise appertaining with the Remainder and Remainders Res-  
ervation and Reversions Rents issues and Profits thereof to the  
only proper use benefit and behoof of him the said Crawford  
& his heirs executors administrators the said Crawford  
and assigns in fee simple and the said William Cay and  
his heirs executors and administrators the said Crawford  
promises unto the said Crawford & his heirs executors  
administrators and assigns against the said Cay & his  
heirs executors and administrators and all and every other  
person or persons who shall and will warrant him  
forever defend by virtue of these presents In Witness
