

Georgia } This Indenture made this twenty fifth day of January  
DeKalb County } in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and forty three  
between William Ferrell of the County and State aforesaid of the  
first and Charles Murphy of the same place of the other part Witnesseth  
that the said William Ferrell hath this day made and delivered to the  
said Charles Murphy his certain promissary note subscribed with  
hand and bearing even date with these presents whereby one day of  
date he promised to pay the said Charles Murphy or bearer Three  
hundred and thirty two dollars & ninety two cents for value received  
now for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars by the said  
Charles Murphy to the said William Ferrell in hand paid the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged as well as for the better securing the pay-  
ment of the said promissary note the said William Ferrell hath  
granted bargained and sold and doth by these presents grant  
bargain and sell unto the said Charles Murphy his heirs and  
assigns a certain Mulatto slave by the name of Dick or Richard  
said Mulatto slave Dick being about twenty seven years of age  
to have and to hold said bargained slave Dick to the said Charles  
Murphy his heirs and assigns to his and their own proper use  
benefit and behoof forever and the said William Ferrell for him-  
self his heirs executors and administrators the said bargain  
property unto the said Charles Murphy will warrant and  
forever defend against the claim of himself and his heirs ex-  
ecutors and administrators against the claim of all other persons whatever pro-  
vided nevertheless that if the said William Ferrell his heirs ex-  
ecutors and administrators shall and do well and truly pay or  
cause to be paid unto the said Charles Murphy his heirs and  
assigns the aforementioned sum of Three hundred and thirty  
two <sup>and</sup> <sup>92</sup> <sup>cents</sup> dollars <sup>and</sup> <sup>92</sup> <sup>cents</sup> on the day and time mentioned and ap-  
pointed for the payment thereof in said promissary note mentioned  
with lawful interest for the same according to the tenor of said  
note then and from thenceforth as well this present inden-  
ture and the right to the property thereby conveyed as the said  
promissary note shall cease determine and be void to all intent  
and purposes her testimony whereof the said William Ferrell  
hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this day and  
year above written Signed Sealed and delivered in presence of  
William S Murphy
