Whereas in DeKalb County a writ of fieri facias issued out of the Superior Court of the County of DeKalb at the suit of the Sheriff of the County of DeKalb against William P. Glom a Sheriff of the County of DeKalb did take the lot of land being after specified as the property of the said William P. Glom and after being duly and publicly advertised according to Law did on the first Tuesday of November in the year one Thousand eight hundred and thirty four at the place of public sales in the said County of DeKalb upon the same at public outcry where Alfred B. Greenwood being the highest bidder the same was knocked off to him at the price of eleven Dollars

Now this Indenture made the first day of January in the year of our Lord one Thousand Eight hundred and thirty five and in the fifty ninth year of the Independence of the United States of America between the said Isaac T. Johnson Sheriff as assignee of the one part and the said Alfred B. Greenwood of the other part Witnesseth that the said Isaac T. Johnson Sheriff as assignee for and in consideration of the sum of eleven Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Alfred B. Greenwood at and before the making and sealing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell so far as the office of Sheriff authorizes him unto the said Alfred B. Greenwood all that tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the Township of Auburn of the County of DeKalb Georgia and distinguished in the plan of said District by the number 59 fifty nine containing two hundred two and a half acres more or less together with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances unto the said Lot of land being belonging or in anywise appertaining and also all the estate right title interest property claim and demand of the said William P. Glom in Law equity or otherwise whatsoever of in or to the same

to have and to hold the said Lot or parcel of land and premises and every part thereof unto the said Alfred B. Greenwood his heirs and assigns to the only proper use benefit and behoof of the said Alfred B. his heirs and assigns forever in fee simple in as full and ample a manner as the said William P. Glom his heirs and assigns then or might have held and enjoyed the same had it not been seized and taken upon the execution aforesaid In Witness whereof the said Isaac T.
