 the rights incidents and appurtenances thereof whatsoever
 to the said Augustus J. Pitts do have and to hold the three
 hundred and three acres of land in full simple fee
 and the said Joseph Pitts his heirs Executors administrators
 shall and will from now and hereafter the said
 tract or parcel of land aforesaid unto the said Augustus
 J. Pitts his heirs and assigns against all and every other

 Thomas William McElwain on the 17th
 day of July in the year 1839 issued his certain bond in the
 penal sum of one thousand Dollars to George W. Feltle con-
 taining that if the said McElwain should make or cause to be
 made good & sufficient warrant to said George W. Feltle
 bearing to the west equal half of lot Number Seventy seven
 in the fifteenth District of originally Shreve now DeKalb
 County to be given to so soon as the purchase money
 should be paid which was one note of hand made pay-
 able the 25th Decem^r be next after the date thereof for one
 hundred & sixty six Dollars & 66 cents one note of hand
 made payable the 25th Decem^r be Eighteen hundred & thirty
 eight for the same amount and one other note made
 payable the 25th Decem^r be Eighteen hundred & thirty seven
 for one hundred and sixty six Dollars & sixty six cents
 then the said bond to be void else to remain in full
 force and said McElwain having departed this life
 & Robert McWilliams being his appointed administrator
 of all and singular the goods & chattels rights & interests
 that were of the estate of the said McElwain

his death by the Court of Ordinary of said County & said
 George W. having been the death of said William complied
 with all the conditions in said bond to be complied on
 his part by paying to said Administrator the balance
 of the purchase money due for said land. And the
 Court of Ordinary of said County on the petition of
 said George W. having passed an order nisi calling
 on all persons interested to show cause if any why
 said Robert as administrator as aforesaid should not
 execute a good warrant title conveying said half lot
 of land to said George W. which order being published
 in one of the public Gazettes of said State according
 to law & no cause having been shown to the contrary
 said Court passed a rule absolute requiring said Robert
 as administrator to execute a good warrant title convey-
 ing said half lot of land to said George W. in compli-
 ance with the said Williams part of said bond.

Now Therefore in consideration of the sum of five
 hundred Dollars we have paid to him the said Robert
 McWilliams by him the said George W. at & before the making
 & signing of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged by the said Robert as Administrator as aforesaid
 hath granted bargained & sold & by these presents doth grant
 bargain & sell unto him the said George W. & to the aforesaid
 name & bargain improvements & appurtenances therunto
 belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said
 George W. & his heirs and assigns to his and their own proper
 use benefit & behoof forever in full discharge of the said Robert
 administrator as aforesaid the before named land with
 all the improvements and appurtenances therunto belonging
 or in any wise appertaining unto him the said George W.
 & his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant & defend
 the legal and equitable title against himself
 and all and every other person or persons whatever as far
 as in law or Equity he may be bound to do as administra-
 tor as aforesaid. In Witness whereof the said Robert
