for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred dollars to him
in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained
sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do give
bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said

his heirs and assigns all the west half of a certain lot
of land situate lying and being in the eighteenth district of orig-
inally Henry but now DeKalb County which lot is known and dis-
tinguished in the plan of said district by the number seven
containing two hundred two & a half acres more or less to have and
to hold the said half lot with all and singular the rights
members and appurtenances thereof whatsoever to the said
lot of land being belonging or in anywise appertaining with the
remainder and remainders reversion and reversions rents issues
and profits thereof to the only proper use benefit and behoof of
him the said George Anderson his heirs executors administrators
and assigns in fee simple and the said Charles Murphy
his heirs executors and administrators the said bargained premises
unto the said George Anderson his heirs executors adminis-
trators and assigns against the said Charles Murphy his heirs
executors and administrators and all and every other person
or persons shall and will warrant and forever defend by virtue

and Lipe Gordon of the county of DeKalb & State of Georgia witnesseth
that for and in consideration of four hundred and fifty dol-
lars to him in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and do by these
presents grant bargain sell and convey unto the said
Gordon his heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of
situate lying and being in the county of

County of Henry at the times of survey containing two hundred
and ~~two~~ half acres more or less known and distinguished in
the plans of said lot as M^o (165) one hundred and sixty three orig-
inally granted to Thomas Davis orphans of Walls district Upper
county on the first of April in the year Eighteen Hundred
and Thirteety two. To have and hold: Said tract of parcel
of land unto him the said Leffe Jordan his heirs and assigns
together with all and singular the rights members and
appurtenances thereof to the same in any manner belonging
to his and their own proper use benefit and behoof for-
ever in fee Simple and the said William Jordan for
himself his heirs executors and administrators the said barg-
ained premises unto the said Leffe Jordan his heirs and assigns
will warrant and forever defend the right and title thereof
against themselves and against the claim of all other persons

respect as myself might or could do were I personally pres-
ent at the doing thereof and also to receive payment for the
above stated premises furthermore to assign my name to
a certain bond or other instrument of writing given to William
Clark as a full settlement between said Clark myself
and brothers ratifying and confirming and by these
present allowing whatsoever my said attorney shall
