Sarnall all that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the fifteenth district of originally G. Cobb County and State of said Georgia containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less siting all of lot 1 & 122 on bargain and being two except one hundred acres taken off of the north side and adjoining the lands of said Paulie John White and others. To have and to hold all and singular the rights, liberties and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to his own proper use benefit and behoof forever unto the said Wm L. Cobb and the heirs, assigns and by virtue of these presents will form defend unto the said M.
